Six gigantic stacked chocolates made from painted aluminum make up **CHOCO TOWER**, a ten-foot-high sculpture by Fairfield resident Peter Anton. The sculpture will be presented by Galerie von Braunbehrens of Stuttgart, Germany, at Art Miami December 4 through 9. "Choco Tower is a continuation of my exploration of textures and use of vibrant colors that celebrate the importance and allure of food within people's lives, both past and present," says Anton.
