Returning to Biscayne Bay for its 29th edition, Art Miami is the city's longest-running fair, thanks to its reliable presentation of 20th-century modern masters and blue-chip contemporary art. **Peter Anton**, who builds large-scale monuments to confectionery and drew crowds to Art Miami in 2012 with his "Sugar & Gomorrah" fairground ride, is returning with a 10-foot aluminium "Choco Tower" presented by Galerie von Braunbehrens. The Instagram-friendly work explores our emotional relationship with chocolate and allows Anton to "connect with people's desires", as he puts it. Nancy Hoffman brings an installation of vintage purses updated by artist Michele Pred with slogans such as "We Vote" and "Me Too". Pred calls them "small-scale political billboards". Context, Art Miami's sister fair, focuses on emerging and mid-career artists.
